**Year 12 students applying to go to University – Your NEW 2017 UAC Guides have arrived and are available NOW to be picked up from the Careers Office. You will need a new UAC guide to help you with your application to go to university. Remember to book your Careers interview with Mr King.**

### UOW Early Admission Information for Students and Teachers

The UOW Early Admission program enables high achieving and motivated students to receive an offer to study at UOW based on their academic performance and commitment to study during Years 11 and 12. Successful students will receive notice of the outcome of their application before they sit their HSC exams. And receive an offer in the UAC early offer round on Dec 9<sup>th</sup>.

#### The Basics

- All students completing Year 12 in 2016 and receiving an ATAR are eligible to apply for UOW Early Admission
- All UOW undergrad degrees will be offered
- Students will be able to apply for up to TWO UOW degrees. Indicative criteria for each degree is listed on the UOW Early Admission website [www.uow.edu.au/early](http://www.uow.edu.au/early) .
- **Applications will only be accepted via the UOW Early Admission website from Monday 1<sup>st</sup> August.**
- Application CLOSE strictly 5.00pm Friday the 26<sup>th</sup> August 2016.
- Students will be assessed by UOW according to their academic performance and a compulsory interview.
- Successful applicants will be made a formal offer to study through UAC December: Friday 9<sup>th</sup> December 2016.

#### Early Admission Key Dates and NOTES

- Applications open Monday 1<sup>st</sup> August 2016 and close 5.00pm 26<sup>th</sup> August 2016 on [www.uow.edu.au/early](http://www.uow.edu.au/early) .
- Shortlisted applicants will be invited to attend a compulsory interview to be held between Monday 26 – Thursday 29 September 2016.
- Students will be informed of their outcome via email 10-11 October 2016.
- Outcomes will either be successful or unsuccessful – there will be NO conditional offers.
- Applicants will receive an outcome for each degree they apply (up to two). One outcome may be successful and the other may be unsuccessful, or both could be successful, or both could be unsuccessful. UOW's decision is final.
- A successful outcome isn't an offer to study at UOW. To convert the outcome into an official offer – the applicant MUST put that course as their first UAC preference by the 5<sup>th</sup> December 2016 so that they may be made an offer in UAC's December round of offers on 9<sup>th</sup> December.

#### SPECIAL NOTES

- If students are shortlisted for an interview they will receive an email inviting them to campus. Attached to the email will be a PDF for them to print off and have signed by a school representative to verify the marks / grades the student has submitted are true and correct. Students will need to provide this signed document at their interview as proof of the marks that they have entered are accurate.

- Students will be asked to enter their marks from Year 11 and Year 12. Students from ISHS are required to put in their **RAW MARKS**.
- Students may request a 'School Statement of Support' (SSS) if they believe they are eligible for special consideration on the grounds of "illness /Injury" or other extenuating circumstances (eg carer responsibilities, significant financial hardship, interrupted schooling). SSS can be completed by Careers Advisers, Counsellors, Teaching or Executive staff only. SSS are completed on line [www.http://bit.ly/UOW\\_SSS](http://bit.ly/UOW_SSS) to sign up as a sponsor.
- Students are asked to register and use the email address that they use and will use beyond the school year finishing. Students are encouraged NOT to use their school email address.
